

Application for the Frank Gaha Prize

Mrs Gaha has donated a sum of \$1000 to the University of Tasmania to endow a prize to commemorate her late husband, Dr Frank Gaha.

The prize will be awarded annually to a student in the School of Medicine who has passed all examinations throughout the MB,BS degree course at the first attempt, and who demonstrates interest and proficiency in General Practice as verified by an essay on a topic to be set by the Head of the Discipline of General Practice. The essay will be written under exam conditions in Hobart, Burnie or Launceston during the week 21-25 September, 2009.

The time allowed will be 55 minutes. The two best essays judged to be of sufficient standard will be awarded the Frank Gaha Prize and the John Daly Memorial Prize (see John Daly Memorial Prize rules).

Students wishing to compete for this award are to submit an expression of interest to the Administrative Officers, Year 4-5/6 Program, Private Bag 96, Hobart 7001 by August 28, 2009. Fill in all sections of the form.

The current value of the award is \$550.
