

## Application for the GP North General Practice Excellence Award

The prize is awarded annually to a final year student who:

- 1 Is enrolled at the Launceston Clinical School.
- 2 Successfully completes all components of the end of year summative assessment for CAM511/512.
- 3 Earns a favourable report from their GP preceptor(s).
- 4 Submits an essay of 2,000 - 3,000 words that displays an exemplary understanding of the vital role of General Practice in patient care.
- 5 Is judged by the academic staff of the Discipline of General Practice and the Head of the Launceston Clinical School to have the potential to excel as a General Practitioner if the student were to enter this vocational stream in years to come.

If necessary a viva voce examination may be conducted in Launceston to determine the recipient of the award.

Students wishing to compete for this award are to submit an expression of interest to the Administrative Officers, Year 4-5/6 Program, Private Bag 96, Hobart 7001 by August 28, 2009. Fill in all sections of the form.

The award consists of \$500 cash and a certificate, and will be presented by the donors.
