

## Application for the John Daly Memorial Prize

Dr and Mrs David Daly donated \$500 to the University in 1974 to honour the memory of their son John.

The prize is awarded annually to a student in the School of Medicine who has passed all examinations throughout the MB,BS degree course at the first attempt, and who submits the best essay on a topic to be set by the Head of the Discipline of General Practice. The two best essays judged to be of sufficient standard will be awarded the John Daly and the Frank Gaha Prize (see Frank Gaha Prize rules). The essay will be written under exam conditions in Hobart, Burnie or Launceston during the week 21-25 September, 2009. The time allowed will be 55 minutes.

The Prize is in the form of a cash prize and a medal. The annual value of the prize is to be determined by the Dean of the Faculty of Health Science, having regard to the income from the endowment and making allowance for the cost of inscribing the medal. The medal will be inscribed with the name of the winner and will be presented at an official ceremony held immediately before the University Graduation Ceremony by the donors or their representative(s).

Dr and Mrs Daly will be notified officially each year by the University of the prize winner, who will be encouraged to write a brief note to the donors.

Students wishing to compete for this award are to submit an expression of interest to the Administrative Officers, Year 4-5/6 Program, Private Bag 96, Hobart 7001 by August 28, 2009. Fill in all sections of the form.

The current value of the prize is \$180.
